
#### **Giving back**

# Northern Pipe Products donates pipe for community projects

Northern Pipe Products has a history of donating PVC pipe to worthwhile causes throughout its community. For example, the company donated pipe to help build a BMX race track in West Fargo, North Dakota, and it contributed its product to the Maple River Golf Course in Mapleton, North Dakota, to improve water control. "It feels great to help out our community in this way," said Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer Lyle Ganyo. "Putting this pipe to good use in our community makes sense."

When the company received a donation request from a local elementary school, it was happy to help out. At Longfellow Elementary in Fargo, many of its teachers wanted to provide standing desks for their students. "Studies show that movement throughout the school day helps students stay more engaged in the classroom," said Principal Eric Henrickson. But when the teachers started experimenting with different materials to elevate the desks, they didn't have much success. "After more research, PVC pipe seemed like the right solution," said Henrickson. "One family contacted Northern Pipe Products, and it donated and cut the pipe to fit the desks."

In total, Northern Pipe Products donated 132 pieces of PVC pipe measuring 2 inches by 18 inches. "We provided enough pipe to fulfill all teacher requests," said Ganyo. "The durability of PVC pipe and its low-maintenance material means these desks will last a long time in the classroom setting."

Henrickson said the standing desks have been a success. "Students, teachers, and parents are all very happy about the improvements the desks have made to the classroom experience. We're grateful to Northern Pipe Products for their generous donation."
